4. Based on the attached Affidavit, Mr. Weiner has never been denied admission to, been disciplined by, resigned from, surrendered his license to practice before, or withdrawn an application for admission to practice before this Court or any other court, while facing a disciplinary complaint.

5. The granting of this motion will not require modification of any scheduling order entered by this Court pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 16(b) or the deadlines established by the standing order on scheduling in civil cases.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned respectfully requests that, upon payment to the Clerk of the United States District Court for the District of Connecticut of the requisite seventy-five dollar fee (\$75.00) for the admission of Attorney Daniel H. Weiner, which is submitted herewith, the Court enter an order permitting Attorney Daniel H. Weiner to represent Defendant Stuart A. Fraser, in this civil action as a visiting lawyer.
